## **Ribbon Prayer Crosses**

## Preparation; you will need

7 gauge plastic canvas

2metres 1/8inch ribbon of your colour choice Scissors

Cut out the cross shape as below 21 x 15

## To Make the cross;

Leave 2" of ribbon spare at the top [to make the hanging loop], then starting from the back These simple crosses also make great bookmarks – leave a longer ribbon to go inside the book so that the cross hangs outside the pages.

Hang some from an Easter Tree as ornaments.

Tie one to the bow of a baptism gift.

Attach to a key ring, or keep in your pocket or purse.

They can be Sunday school crafts for those who are old enough to handle scissors.

bring the ribbon through to the front through #1 hole, then through to the back through #2 hole, through to the front through #3 hole, continue to #21 hole. To make the cross over in the centre take the ribbon from 21 to the lower right of the centre marked a on the diagram, wrap the ribbon around the cross, a-b-c-d-a pulling tight to gather all the ribbon together [see photo], then back up to #1. Tie this end of the ribbon and the piece left at the start together in a knot. Make a hanging loop or finish with beads as in the photo.
