Tomorrow, Saturday 27<sup>th</sup> is designated as a Global Day when many of you will be taking part in special prayer services. If you cannot join with others , if you can't do anything else, please wear a purple scarf to show solidarity with those who suffer violence and abuse of this type. Also at 1.03pm please join in with 3 minutes silence to represent the fact that 1 in 3 women and girls will suffer in this way during their lifetime.

Included would also be details of the Big Give Christmas appeal to support women across South Africa, Kenya and Uganda.
